This has happened in another area, it is the polite thing to do to ask if it is permissible to take photos at event, especially anything with prominent NA symbols in the foreground or background. It would be extremely hard to police since it is difficult to know when someone is taking a photo or video. Vandy brought up that at several events have made several clarity statements regarding this issue. Odie brought up that at an event from out of state that it was announced that if you take pictures you should only take them of members who are agreeable to this, and it was also announced if photos are taken then they are not to be posted on any social networking sites. Kevin feels that this is the time as a Region that we take a step to educate our members regarding this issue, maybe take this to the Western Regional Service Workshop in Oakland. Nick brought up that at their last PR meeting, they addressed what is put on walls, pictures posted and such, how it makes NA appear, and NA is getting a black eye from this behavior. Dave W, brought to the attention of the body that the last Western Regional Service Workshop this year and the response from World was posted in the January 2011 minutes in open forum. Kevin our webservant mentioned again that educating our members about this – Dan brought up that if you dicuss this issue with 5 friends and they mention it to 5 friends than we can educate our members better than sitting thru a workshop. It was also brought up that the security of these social sites is very easily compromised and our anonymity is now invalid.

**The area affected and that brought this motion to region discussed this more for further clarification for the RCM's taking this back to their areas, they do have a very large deaf community, they have the Washington State school for the deaf in their area. This area has already been paying for interpreters at Area level meeting (they have currently 3 GSR's coming from three area meetings that are deaf). They came to Region several years ago for some assistance on this issue and received it, the money that they requested finally ran out and their attempt at supporting this on their own is struggling that is why they came to region for some assistance.c. Insurance from Region - Members contacting Insurance Company directly for insurance of events, is NOT allowed. You must go thru the Insurance Coordinator of the C&E body. This insurance binder is a blanket coverage for NA events in our region, if your facility (where the event is being held) requires an insurance binder is when you would want to contact the coordinator to request a binder, there is specific information that is required to complete the binder request and you need to not wait until the day before or the day of the event to procure this. There will be a frequency asked questions link on the regional website about insurance.**

We have the jail clearance forms table set up in the lobby for anyone with 1 year clean or more and 3 years off paper that would like to help carry the NA message into the King County Jail. Please stop by to say hello to Caulda and she will assist you in filling out the forms. We are half way through our pilot project and effort to increase our resource pool which better enables us to carry our message and give more of our members the opportunity to experience this type of service. Please continue to make this announcement at your meetings.
